

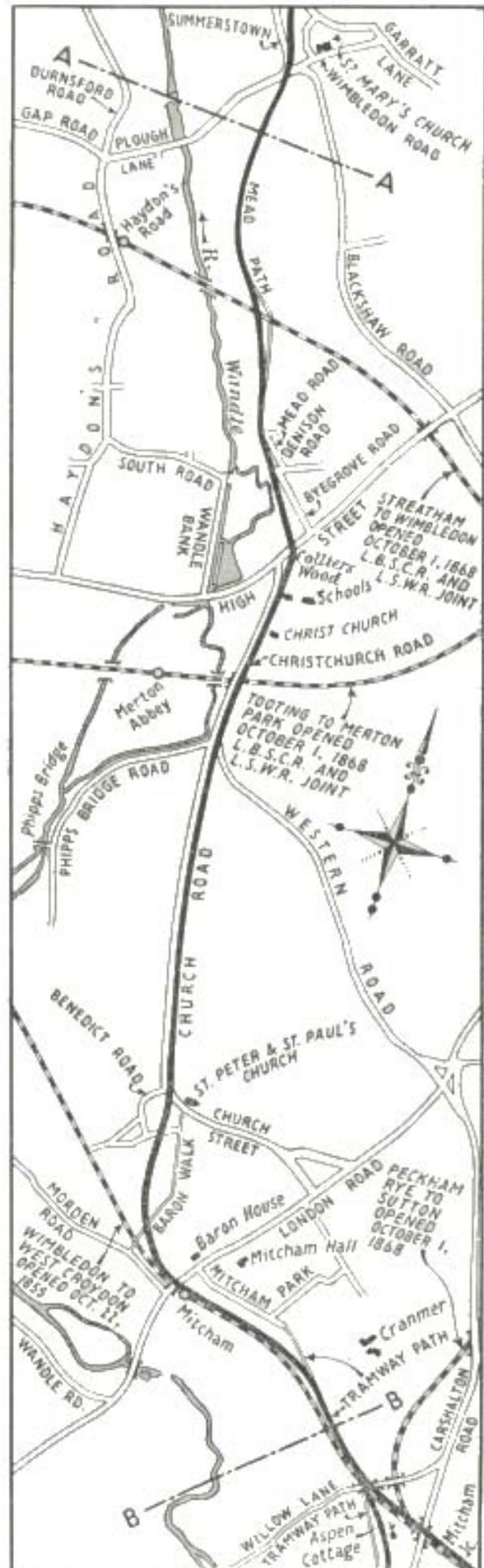
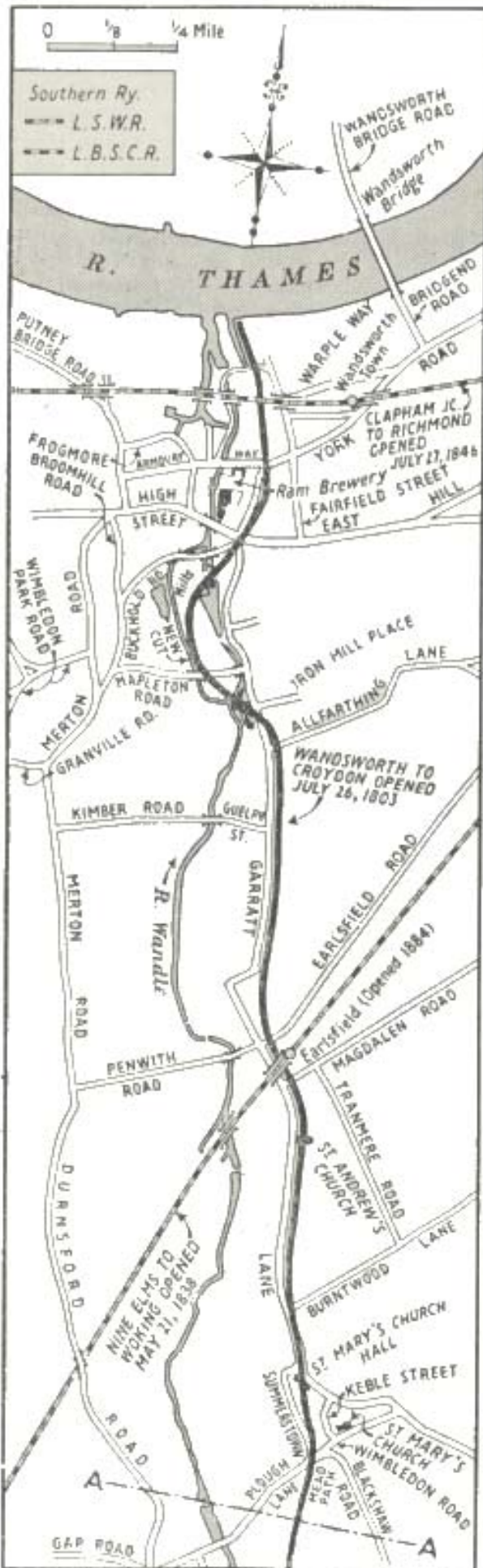
The Route of the 1803 Surrey Iron Railway

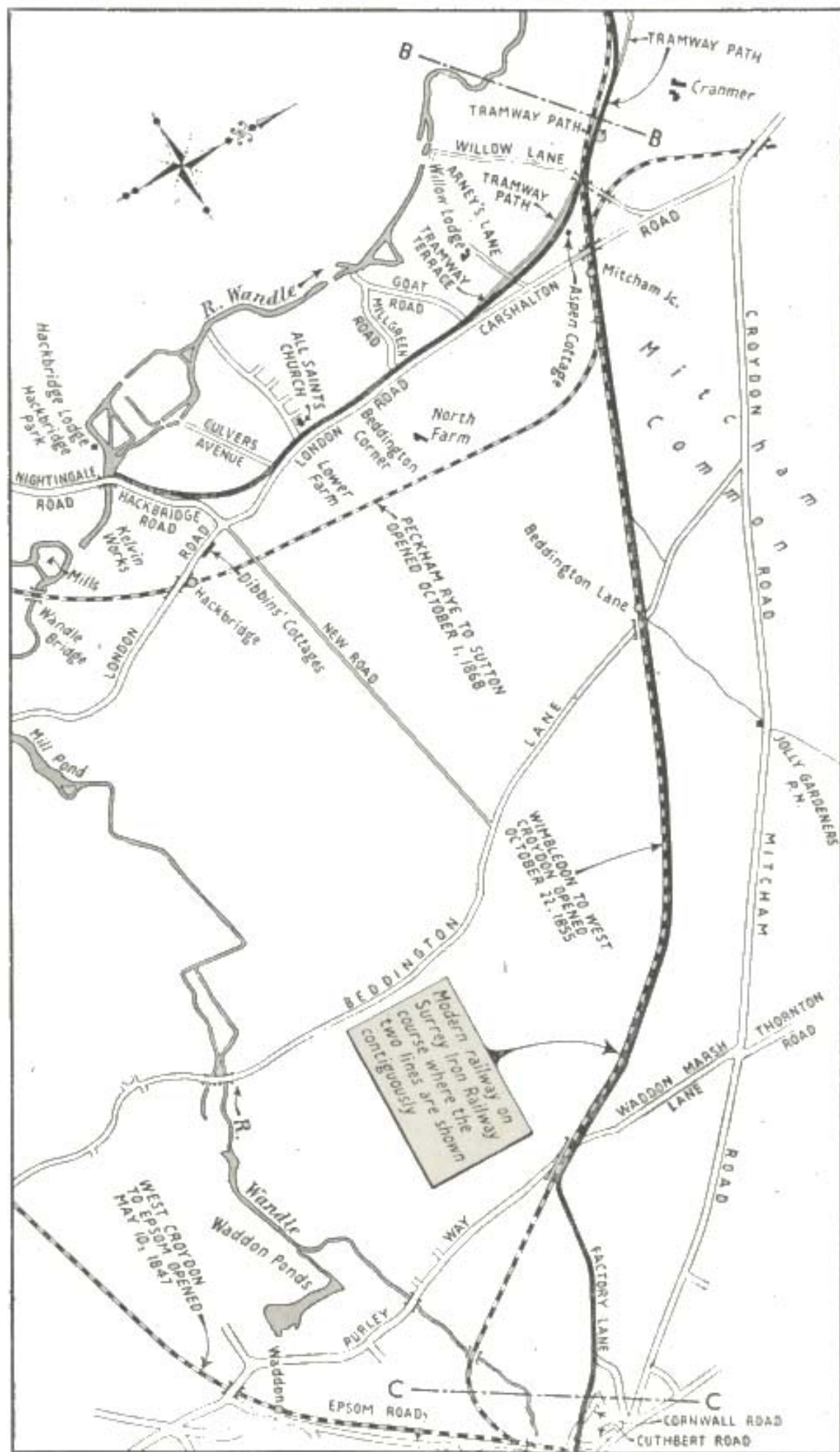
Surrey Iron Railway

Wandsworth-Croydon line.

This constituted the Surrey Iron Railway which was the world's first public railway, and was incorporated in 1801. In view of building developments since the line was abandoned

on August 31, 1846, it is not possible to show some sections of the route with absolute precision in relation to modern topographical details, but the points of uncertainty are very slight.
